► With floor-to-ceiling windows, experience panoramic views of the city skyline and the Parkway year-round on a spacious and heated balcony with automatic sliding glass doors. There's also an onsite fitness center, pool, conference room and hospitality suite.

IDEAL LOCATION

► Find the perfect balance of being in the city but surrounded by greenspace. The new building will be an easy ride into the heart of Center City, but far enough away to relax in your backyard park.

PRIVATE GARDEN

► The pièce de résistance is the private half-acre garden (available only to residents but visible to all), with an outdoor living room, kitchen, pergola, water wall and stunning seasonal blooms.
